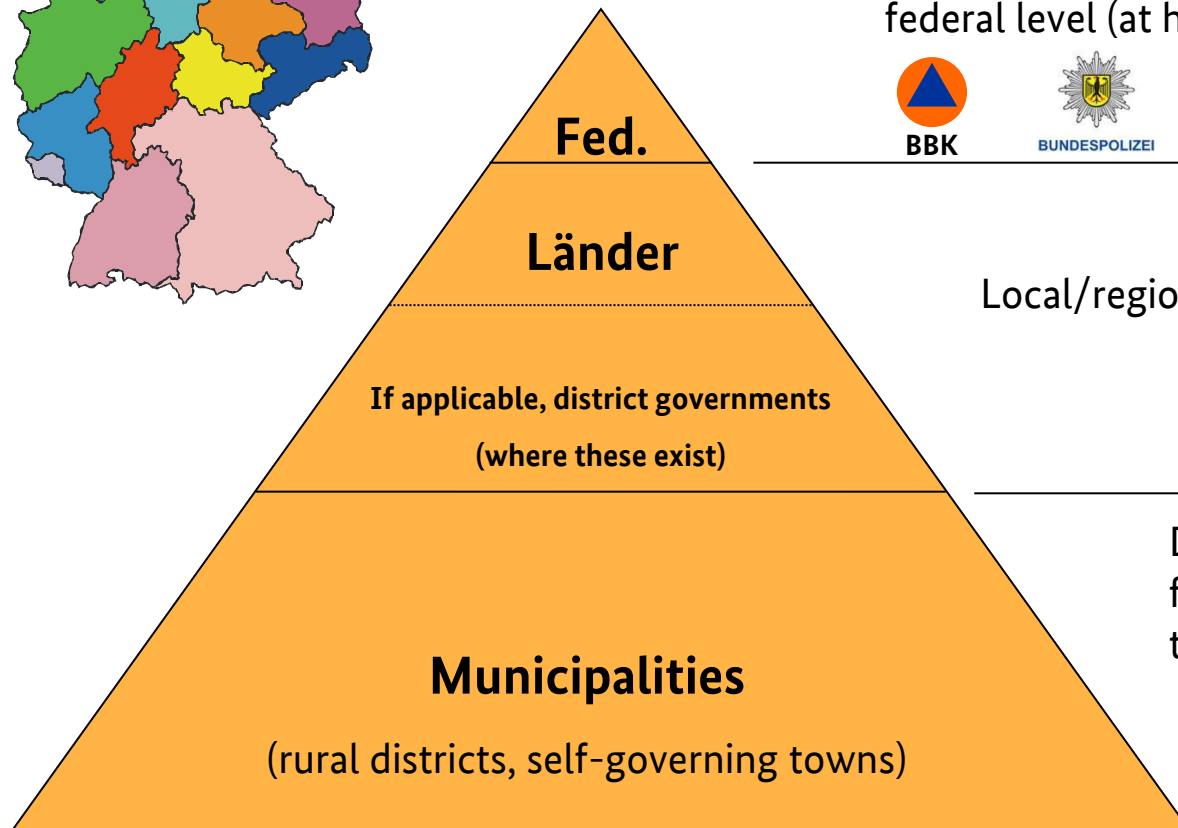

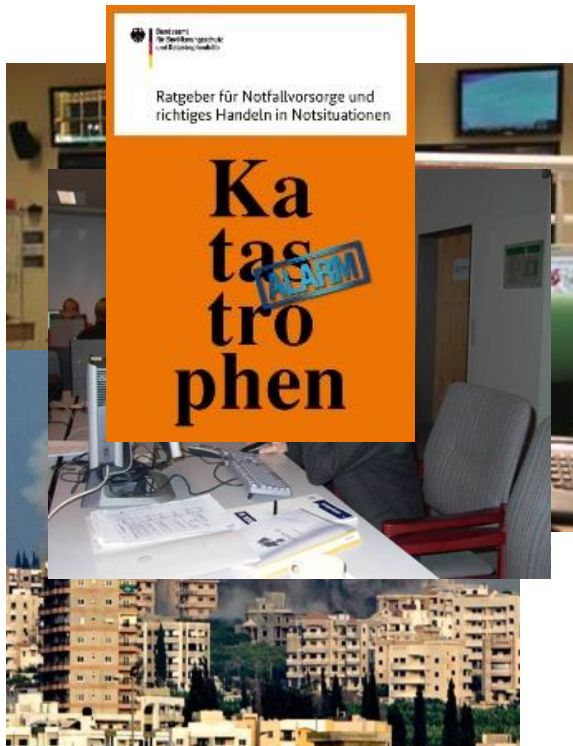

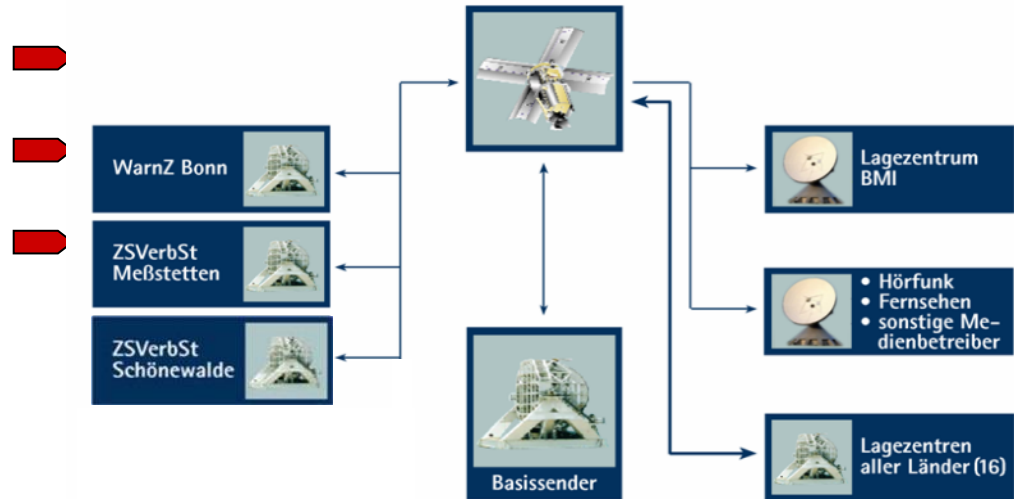
Tasks of the BBK

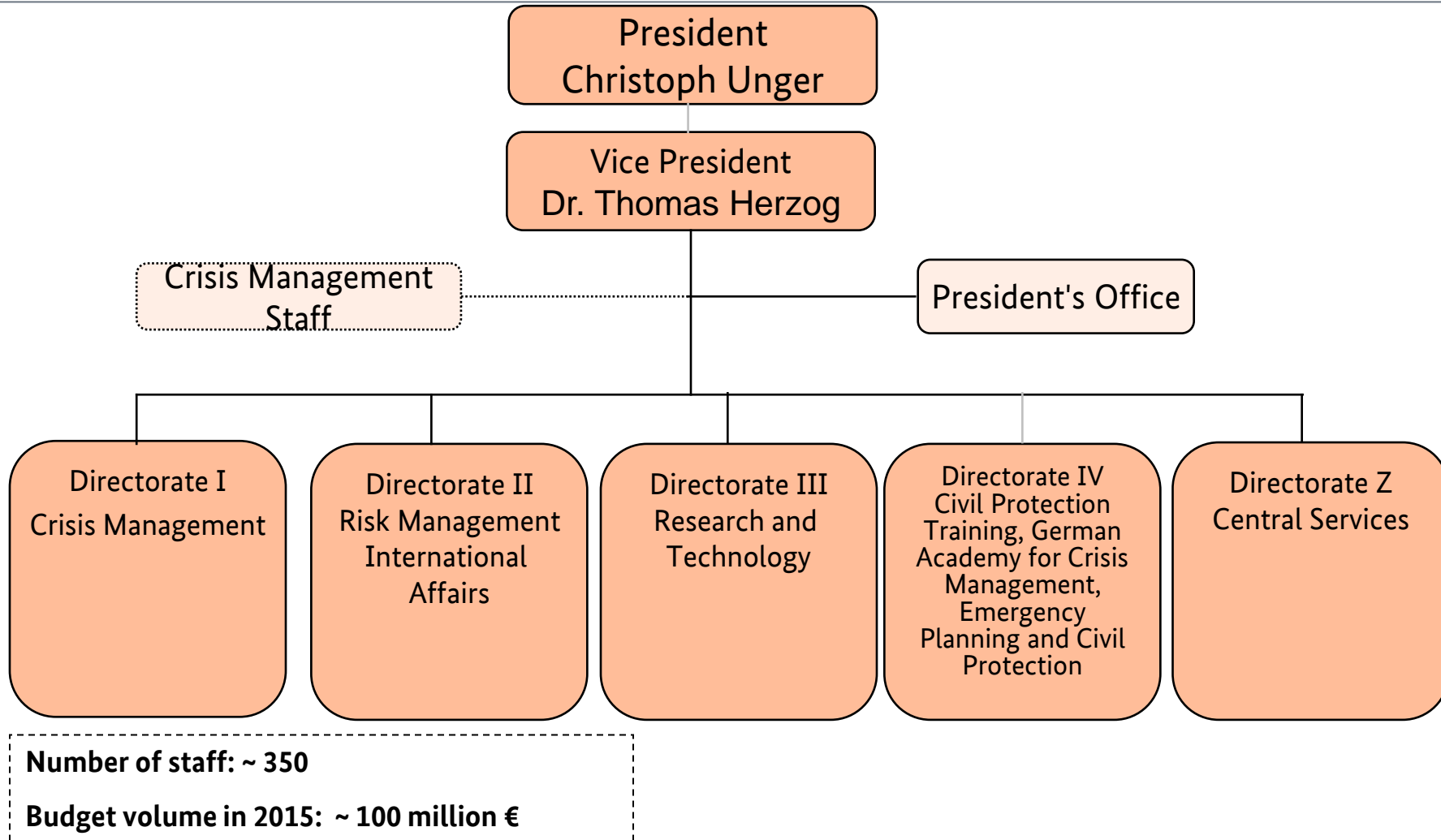
The tasks of the BBK include, among others:

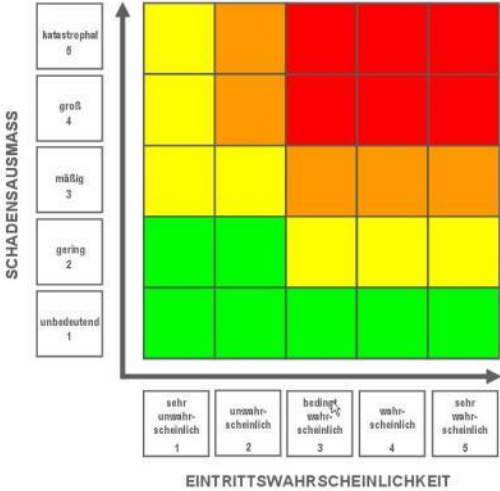

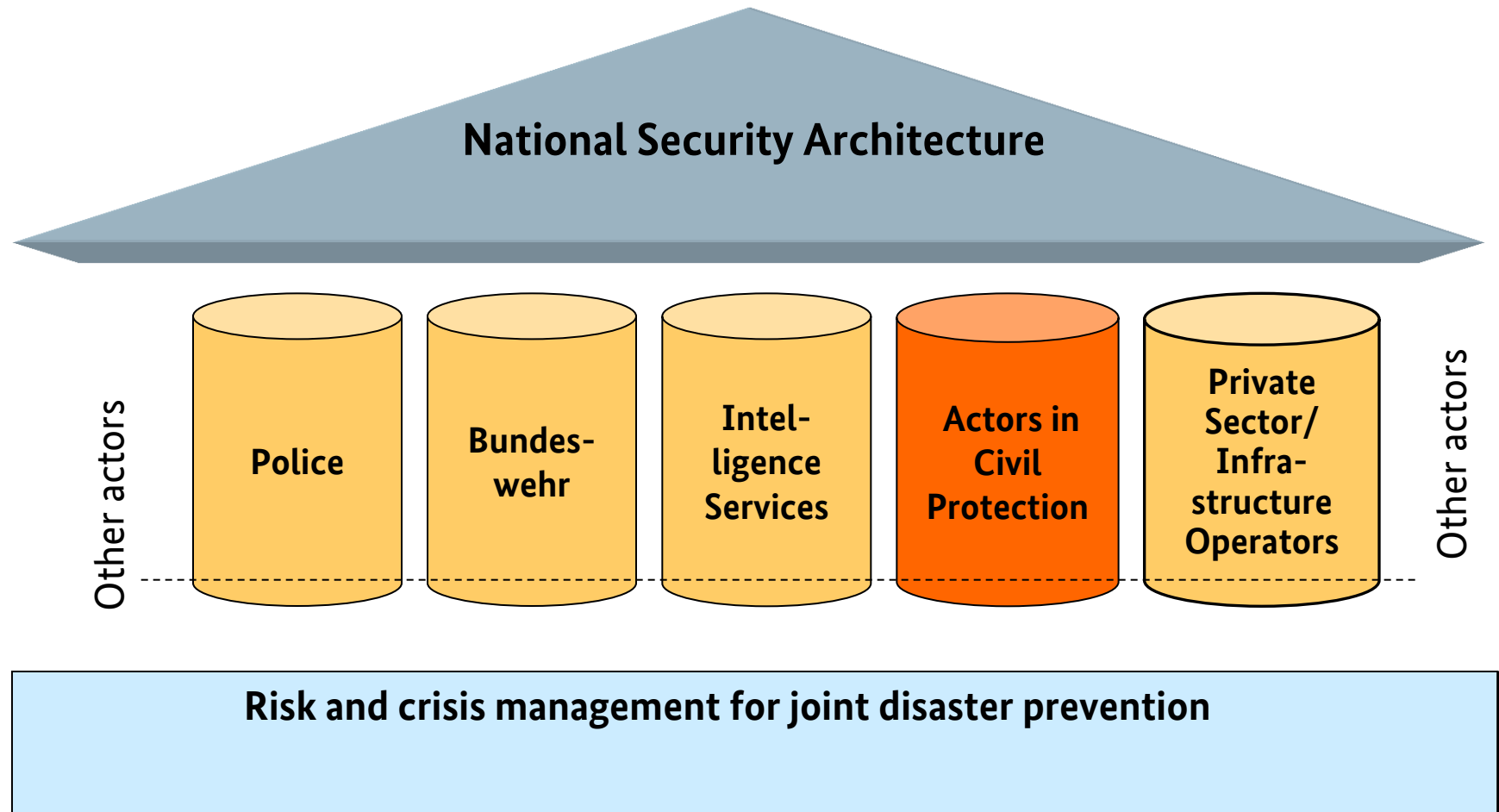

Tasks of the AKNZ

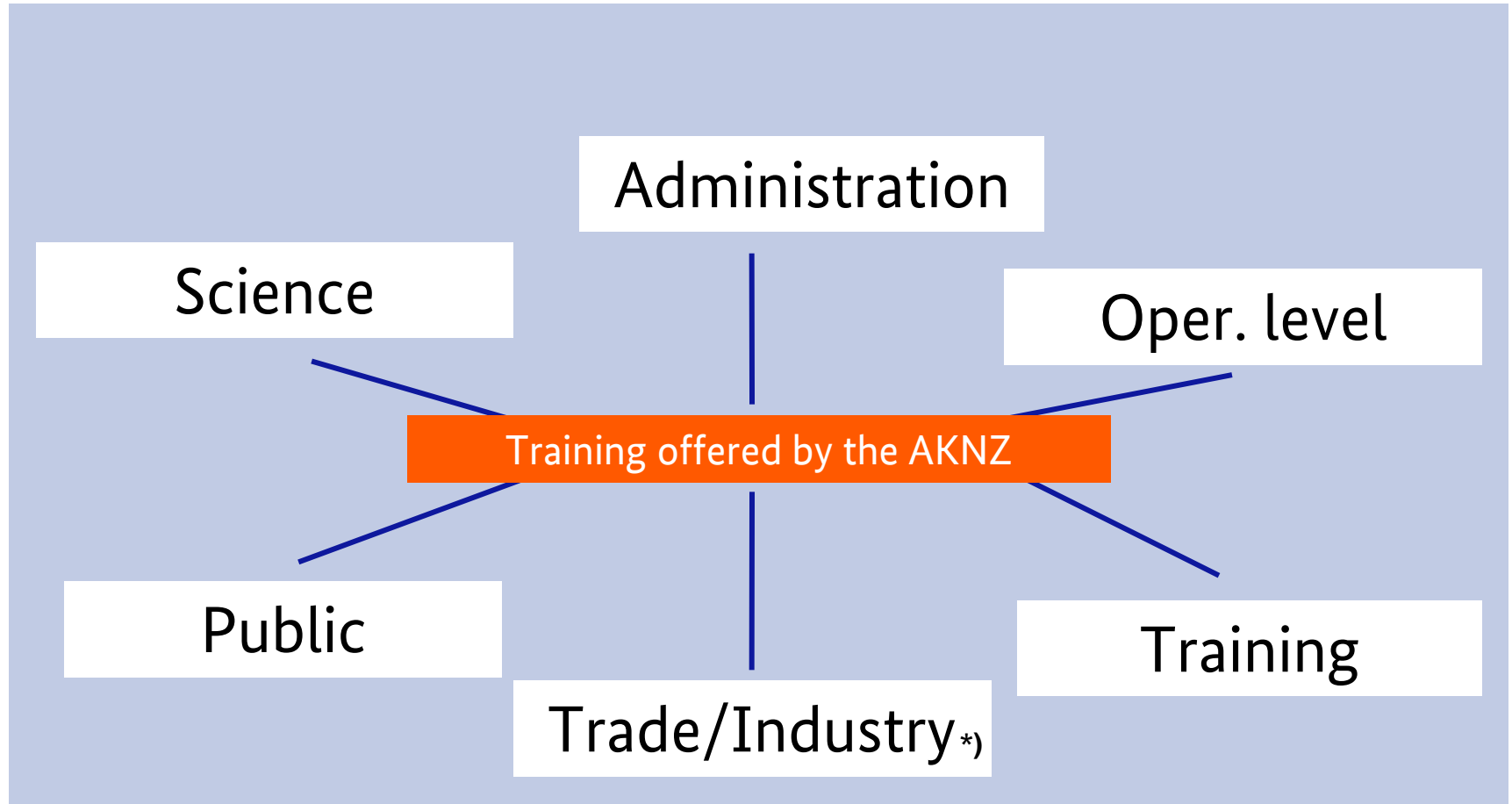
- Basic and continuing training of **personnel concerned with civil preventive security measures** and of **executive personnel working in population protection**

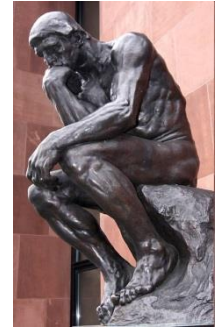

The AKNZ "Educational Concept" Practical and Skill-Oriented Courses

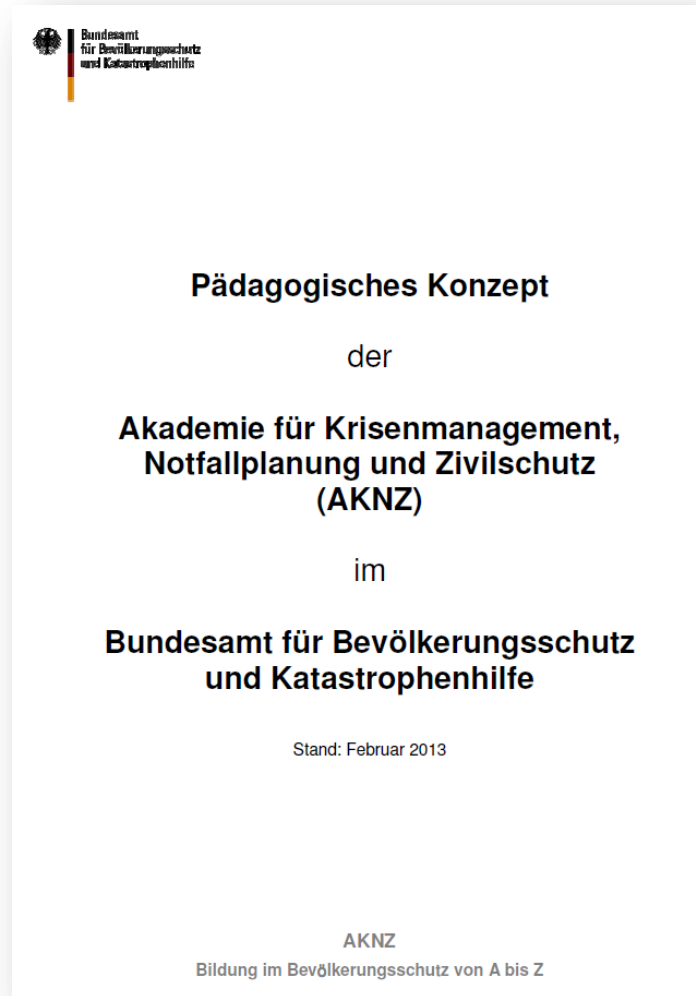


Competence to act:

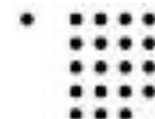
